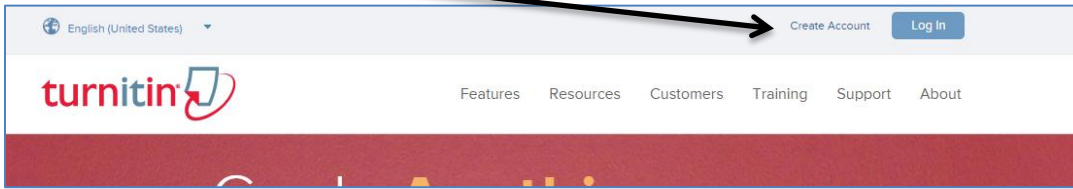



## Signing Up for Turnitin

1) Go to [www.turnitin.com](http://www.turnitin.com)

2) Choose "Create Account" in the upper right




3) Choose "Student" under the "Create a New Account" (if you have used turnitin before, fill in the first section)

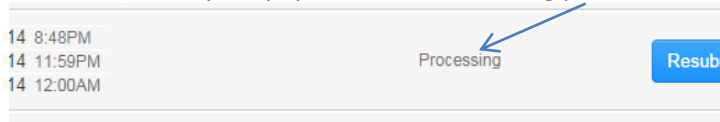
5) And then fill in your other information (add accurate info including an email address that you can access) and finally click on the "I Agree" button.
