Children of Men (2006) Directed by Alfonso Cuarón

You all already have notes from re-watching the scene, you now have a bookmark that reminds you of all you have learned. **As a group, analyze your scene from** *Children of Men*.

On the poster, in an **organized and readable way**, describe all you can about the scene. There may be some things you list, but more of your notations should **describe** the "whys" and "how do you know" - **Watch the scene again, look up information, look at the screenplay** (it is posted on today's date on the class website), **discuss...**

The more you can see, understand, and describe the better. This is a challenge: there are two groups doing the same scene – the group who is able to analyze the scene with more detail and explanation will get a better grade.

Notes:

- 1) add a title that is/includes movie name;
- 2) while it may be hard especially for the later scenes, <u>do not outwardly give away the movie</u> (ie: be subtle, don't say "the baby" or "the birth" etc.);
- 3) in the corner/s of the poster, review the movie with a tweet-length statement (each of you can take a corner; you can collectively write a review statement on one or two corners...) be brief/succinct
- 4) these <u>posters will be put up</u>, please be sure they are neat and legible if you want to write on paper and glue it on or type & print parts in an efficient manor, you can do that.
