Get started by following these steps to activate your *New York Times* All Access Account:

1. While at school and connected to school Wi-Fi, go to nytimes.com/grouppass.
2. Click "**Create Account.**" Enter your email address and click "**Continue.**" If you do not already have an account, you will need to create a password.
 - Use a personal email or your school email.
3. You will be prompted to indicate if you are **Student or Staff**.
4. You will get a notice that "You've Claimed your NYTimes Pass!" Click "**Get Started**" to continue setting up and personalizing your New York Times experience.
