 - Physical (including choice reading checkout & research)
 - Online
 - Purchasing
- The space (for use with/without necessitating library resources)
 - For instruction (me/you)
 - For group work/Socratic seminars
 - For research or writing mindset (new location = new attitude)

A general lesson (complete in a regular class period)

A more in-depth lesson (done in a block period)

- Welcome
- Library Info
- Skyline Canvas Page
- Library Canvas Page
- Intro AI discussion
- How-to: NoodleTools project (create, name, share)
- Resources/Databases Intro find evidence from two database
- *How-to:* Add citations to project
- How-to: Create Works Cited page and identify in-text citations
- How-tos create a graded (by Elisabeth) assignment

These possible plans would work for any class. The research section can be more specific/integrated to a current assignment.

And as always, we can change any part of the lesson to work better for individual teachers/classes/students.
